

## **EDUCATIONAL HERITAGE**

### **Background**

The Board of Education supports the retention and preservation of educational artifacts and archival records that document the historical heritage of schooling in the area encompassed by School District No. 57 (Prince George).

There is educational and social value in preserving the history of the District.

### **Procedures**

1. Space in a school district facility may be designated for the storage and safekeeping of relevant educational artifacts and records.
2. The school district will support the efforts of the Educational Heritage Committee of the Prince George Retired Teachers' Association in maintaining the educational heritage of the area by providing assistance limited to in kind or in services, such as access to the internal mail service, reasonable amounts of photocopying and liaison on related issues when possible.
3. The school district will encourage the compilation, collection, restoration and preservation of significant records, major reports, textbooks, school and classroom furnishings and objects and any other item that has relevance to education in this region since public schools were first established in 1915.
