A New Logo

SD57 has hired Monogram Communications to lead a consultative process to design a new logo, as the current one no longer reflects the district or community. The new logo aims to foster pride and belonging, with input gathered from partners and communities. The design will be revealed in September 2025. More details will be shared on our website soon.

2025-2026 Draft Annual Budget

The draft 2025–2026 Annual Budget was presented. Public feedback is invited via [online survey or written submission](#) from April 9–22. Input will be shared at the public Committee of the Whole meeting on April 29, ahead of final approval of the budget on May 13.

Decisions of the Board

Capital Bylaw No. 2025/26 CPSD57-01 was adopted by the Board to allow for Minor Capital Programs. This approves funding from the Ministry of Infrastructure for School Enhancement Program upgrades (HVAC) to Beaverly Elementary and College Heights Elementary.

The Board approved the Superintendent of Schools recommendation that the Board extend the existing Strategic Plan to June 30, 2027 and that a process be developed to support the 2026 Board to edit, update or recreate the Strategic Plan. This extension allows for a four-year cycle that aligns with future Board elections allowing each new Board to shape it according to their vision.
