Audited Financial Statements **June 30, 2025**

The [audited financial statements](#) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, were presented and approved. Enhancing Student Learning Report

The Board of Education received the school district's 2025 Enhancing Student Learning Report (ESLR): [Part 1: Review Data and Data Evidence](#) [Part 2: Response to Results](#).

As part of a strategic planning cycle, each district team produces an annual Enhancing Student Learning Report. In 2025, a 3-year submission cycle was introduced for the ESLR. Within this 3-year cycle, each district will submit the ESLR and two Interim Progress Reports.

2026-2/27 Food Infrastructure Program

The Board of Education approved the 2026/27 Food Infrastructure Program [submission](#).

The Food Infrastructure Program (FIP) is an annual program intended to assist Boards of Education with creating, improving, or expanding infrastructure to feed students. FIP is tied to the government's broader Feeding Futures program, which is a commitment to ensure students are properly fed to enhance positive academic and health outcomes for students.
