Enhancing Student Learning Report

At the September 9, 2025 regular public meeting the Board received the 2025 Framework for Enhancing Student Learning Report.

The Board was provided with a copy of the [2025 Framework for Enhancing Student Learning Report](#) as submitted to the Ministry of Education and Child Care.

School Catchment and Capacity Review

The Board of Education approved a review of all Prince George area school catchment boundaries and feeder school alignment. A preliminary report will be brought to the Committee of the Whole in December 2025, with a final report to the Board for consideration at the January 2026 Board meeting.

Preliminary District Enrolment Report

The Board was provided with the preliminary district enrolment as at September 30, 2025 for information.

The preliminary report shows a total student enrolment of 13,037 which is a reduction of 178.830 FTE from September 30, 2024 and a reduction of 72.518 FTE from 2025/2026 projections.

Final enrolment numbers will be confirmed later this month. The 2025/2026 Operating Grant, based on final enrolment numbers, is provided by the Ministry of Education and Child Care in December.
