Regular Public Meeting Highlights

January 13, 2026

Presentations to the Board

- Representatives of the District Student Advisory Council provided an overview of their recent and upcoming activities.
- The Duchess Park Family of Schools provided a [presentation](#) on learning in their school as it relates to the priorities of the Strategic Plan. The schools presented strategies to improve student success and graduation, including a focus on Grade 10 core academics, strengthened Grade 8–9 transitions, and embedded literacy and numeracy supports.

- Representatives of the Special Olympics / Summer Games Committee provided a [presentation](#) to the Board in appreciation of the support provided by the school district during the event.



SD57 Graduation Rates

The Superintendent reported that overall and Indigenous [graduation rates](#) are at their highest levels to date, while emphasizing continued focus on improvement.

Governance and Policy Modernization

The Board of Education advanced governance modernization work, including the second reading of the Board Procedures Bylaw and the repeal of multiple outdated policies, with content either governed by legislation or transitioned to administrative procedures. The Board emphasized clarity, efficiency, and alignment with legislative requirements.

2026 – 2031 Strategic Plan Development

A [media release](#) was provided advising that School District 57 Board of Education is launching the development of a new Strategic Plan for 2026-2031, a five-year roadmap that will guide the district's priorities, decisions, and investments in student learning and well-being.

Facilities, Enrolment, and Capacity Management

The Board approved measures related to enrolment pressures and facilities, including maintaining French Immersion kindergarten registration limits at College Heights Elementary, adjusting kindergarten enrolment at Heritage Elementary effective September 2026, and approving the purchase of two portables for Heritage Elementary using local capital funds.
