

FEE PAYING STUDENTS

The Board of Education recognizes that occasionally, out of province and out of country families who are not ordinarily resident in British Columbia, may wish to have their children attend a school in the district.

“Ordinarily resident” status is defined when, on the basis of objective evidence, a person has established a regular, habitual mode of life in the community with a sufficient degree of continuity which has persisted despite temporary absences. Ordinarily resident status will be granted in accordance with the School Act and Ministry of Education and Child Care policy.

As these students receive no funding from the province, tuition fees will apply.

The yearly tuition fee will be established commensurate with provincial funding. Payment of fees must be made in advance to the District.
